Application Instructions

A lama may be registered only by its present owner.

1. Provide the requested information and obtain all required signatures. (Incomplete applications could result in a delay of certificate issue.) Photographs optional for alpacas.
2. Provide required color photographs (see requirements below).
3. Include the appropriate fee in US funds (see the fee schedule to the right).
4. Mail white portion to the ILR; keep yellow copy for your records.

Animal Identification

Naming Rules

Any name beginning with a letter or a digit and having 35 or fewer characters (including punctuation and spaces) is acceptable with the following conditions:

- Names must differ by at least one letter from all other names in the Registry;
- Names may not infringe on another owner's reserved breeder identifier;
- Names may not infringe on another owner's protected name;
- Names may not include or refer to breeder identifiers, ranch names or personal names other than those of the breeder.

Photograph Requirements

(Optional for alpacas.)

- 2 required (left, right), 4 recommended (add front, back)
- Must be in color
- 3 1/2" x 5" or 4" x 6" in size (photographs cropped to other sizes or shapes not acceptable)
- No other animals included in photographs
- Lama's name, owner name and owner code must be printed on back of each photograph
- Digital photographs must be printed on photographic weight paper and meet quality standards of dye based photographs.

DNA Analysis

The Registry strongly recommends DNA Analysis as an aid to validation of parentage of all lamas. DNA can be obtained from BLOOD on an FTA card or from FIBER.

LLAMAS which must have DNA Analysis are:

- Sires having 9 or more registered or listed crias;
- Sires used for outside service (effective 1/1/95);
- Listed llamas applying for screening (effective 3/15/96).

ALPACAS must have a DNA sample on file to be registered and have DNA qualified parents.

If you wish to have the FTA card stored for possible future testing, make sure you indicate so when sending in your sample.

If testing is done, you will receive a DNA Analysis Report when the date is available. The report will be mailed to you directly from the ILR office. Any questions must be directed to the ILR office, not to the serology lab.

Microchips

The Registry recommends permanent identification by microchip implantation.

- Microchips are to be implanted at the base of the left ear.
