

Interstate Transportation Health Requirements for Llamas and Alpacas

This chart is an updated version of the one **Llama Life II** originally published in *Issue No. 57, Spring 2001*. The information has been compiled from data available online and should be used as a guide, but not as an official record.

Prior to transporting your animals you should confirm the requirements for the state to which you are traveling. In general, all animals moving intra- or interstate should be free of infectious, contagious or communicable disease and should have

permanent identification (microship, tattoo, ear tag).

Many states request that you send a copy of your health papers to the state veterinarian prior to your arrival.

Please note; no state lists any

requirements for BVDV testing in camelids.

Animals originating from certified "free" herds. 6. Animals entering for exhibition only; 7. Nursing young with negative mothers; 8. Animals under 12 months; 9. Animals under 4 months.

Additional requirements key: A. Proof of vaccinations; B. Free of and/or treated for external parasites; C. Subject to additional testing or quarantine; D. Animals 4 months and older must be treated for scabies. E. Negative for Vesicular Stomatitis; F. Negative for screwworms; G. Animals from Michigan's modified accredited zone have additional requirements; H. Negative to exposure of infection by *Mycobacterium johnes* or *Parelaphostrongylus tenuis*; I. Rabies vaccination required.

*Specific tests required. Requirements apply to New World Camelids. CVI stands for certificate of veterinary inspection.
